ANNOUNCEMENT

It is with great pleasure the Swedish Figure Skating Association and Gothenburg Figure Skating Federation invite you to participate in the 14th Leon Lurje Trophy. The competition is an international competition to be held in memory of Dr Leon Lurje, the former chairman of the ISU Synchronized Skating Technical Committee.

1. GENERAL

Leon Lurje Trophy will be held in accordance with the ISU Constitution, the ISU General Regulations 2018, ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2021, as well as all relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Leon Lurje Trophy 2022 is open for teams who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108 (paragraph Age limits for Synchronized Skating), and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirement in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

Passports of all skaters, as well as the respective permit of an ISU Member different from the one the Team is competing for, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

2. PLACE & DATE

Leon Lurje Trophy will be held in Gothenburg, Sweden, in the arena Frolundaborg. January 27 to January 30, 2022. The arena is located 30 minutes by bus from Gothenburg international airport Landvetter.

3. TECHNICAL DATA

All competition events and official practice sessions will be held at Frolundaborg Arena in Gothenburg (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

Extra ice for unofficial practice will be held in different Practice rinks in Gothenburg, Practice rink 2, the rink Slottsskogshallen, 50 meters from the Main Arena and in the Main Arena.

Senior ISU

At least 15 years before July 1, 2021.

16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Short Program 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less, Factor 0.8

Free Skating 4 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2236 Senior Short Program and Senior Free Skating.

Junior ISU

At least 13 years and have not reached the age of 19 (*) before July 1, 2021.

16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Short Program 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less, Factor 0.8

Free Skating 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2236 Junior Short Program and Junior Free Skating.

Advanced Novice

At least 10 years and have not reached the age of 15 (*) before July 1, 2021.

16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2238 Advanced Novices.

Advance Novice Teams will be skating two (2) Free Skating programs, the Total Segment Score for each Free Skating program will be multiplied by a factor of 0.5 and added together to the Teams Total Competition Score.

Basic Novice

At least 10 years and have not reached the age of 15(*) before July 1, 2021

12 to sixteen (16) Skaters with a maximum number of 4 alternates.

Free Skating 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2238 Advanced Novices.

(*) = A one year extension of the upper age limit may be permitted for some Novice and Junior teams as set out in ISU Communication 2316. Teams who are granted such an extension need to show the certificate confirming the exception issued by the ISU.

4. COVID 19

5. ENTRIES

Entries of teams

Preliminary entry

Please let us know your intention to participate in the competition and let us have your preliminary entry not later than November 30, 2021. Use Entry Team Preliminary **FORM 01**.

Final entry

Your final entry must come to us through official Entry **FORM 02**

With the Entry Form the Team should attach the Planned Program Content Sheet, use PPC **FORM 03** which must be signed by either the Coach or the Team Leader. The Planned Program Content Sheet may be changed at the time of the registration to the competition.

With the entry Form the Team should also send their Music Information, use Music **FORM 04**

Each team is also asked to attach a team photo in digital format of each individual team and asked to send us a short video presentation of the Team (maximum 30 seconds) latest January 2, 2022

Send your Preliminary Entry **FORM 01** latest November 30, 2021, and Entry **FORM 02** latest December 17, 2021 to registration@leonlurjetrophy.com

Entries of officials and judges

Each participating ISU Member may enter one (1) judge listed on the ISU list for Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating. Two (2) judges may be entered if the member is participating with at least 4 teams in different categories.

According to ISU Rules the panel of officials for each category will include:

- 1 Technical Controller
- 2 Technical Specialists
- 1 Referee
- Minimum of 5 Judges
- Assistants to the Panel (1 Assistant Referee Ice, 1 Data Operator, 1 Replay Operator).

The first Judges meeting will be held Thursday January 27 at 19h00 at the Official Hotel.

The Organizing Committee will pay for travel expenses for the invited Referee, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay operators only. Travel expenses for Judges are to be paid by each ISU Member.

The Organizing Committee will provide ground transportation, accommodation, and meals, from lunch on Thursday, January 27th to breakfast on Monday, January 31st, for the invited Referee, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators and nominated judges. Please send us the Entry Officials **FORM 05**, not later than December 17, 2021

10. ACCREDITATION AND REGISTRATION

Officials, Judges and Members of the Official Team Delegation who are taking part in the Leon Lurje Trophy are requested to register for the competition **on Thursday January 27 at the Main Arena Frolundaborg 16h00-19h00**. The Team Leaders/Managers are requested to bring copies of passports of all the skaters (a Team-folder, sorted in the alphabetical order) and present all the passports at the time of registration.

Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member. The ISU Member certifies with the signed entry form the indicated functions of all team members. Any misuse of any function will be sanctioned by the OC.

Please be advised that accreditation will be given to all appointed Judges and Teams' Delegations officially entered and named through their National Associations as follows:

- Skaters 20 skaters per team
- Team Leaders 1 per country
- Team Managers 1 per Team
- Official Coaches 2 per Team
- Team Service Personnel 2 per Team
- Team Medical Personnel 1 per Team

11. MUSIC, MEDIA INFORMATION, PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET

Rule 823 § 2 and Rule 724 shall apply. All teams shall provide competition music of excellent quality in MP3 format. We would be grateful to receive your music in advance, not later than the 17 December 2021 and sent to music@leonlurjetrophy.com. Please do not forget to label your music link with team name, country, category, and which program it is.

Upon registration Team Leader or Team Manager shall bring music copies on USB or two (2) quality copies of their music on CD. Please notice that for Teams who will use Extra Practice Ice will do their own playback through USB or CD.

The music must also be submitted by the Team Leader at the time of Registration.

All music must be properly inserted in their original cases and must be clearly identified with the name of the Team and must show the exact running time of the music (no skating time), which shall be certified by the Team Leader or Team Manager when submitted at the time of registration.

The titles, composers, and orchestra of the Music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be listed for each Team on the Team Music **FORM 05**. The form shall be attached with the Official Entry and sent to registration@leonlurjetrophy.com, latest December 17, 2021.

With the entry forms, the "Planned Program Content" must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Planned Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

12. DRAWS

The Official draws for the competition will take place Thursday January 27 at 20h00 at the Official Hotel. Team Captains, Team Leaders, Coaches and Team Officials are invited to participate at the official draw.

13. JUDGES AND OFFICIALS MEETING

Referee and Technical Panel Meeting will take place Thursday 27 at 18h00 and the First Judge Meeting will take place Thursday 27 at 19h00. Both meetings will be at the Official Hotel, Quality Hotel 11.

14. TEAM LEADER MEETING

The Team Leader meeting will take place 19h15, Thursday 27 at the Official Hotel, Quality Hotel 11.

15. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TRANSPORTATION, SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

Organizer will arrange transportation from/to Landvetter International Airport/Gothenburgs Railway Station to/from the Official Hotel, Quality Hotel 11 and the Ice Rink. The Official Hotel is located approximately 7 km from the Ice Rink. Shuttle bus between the Official Hotel and the Ice Rink will be

provided by the Organizer from Thursday to Sunday.

20. LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each member participating in the Leon Lurje Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for the athletes, Officials, and all other members of the Member's Team(s). Such insurance must provide full medical coverage and the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The ISU, the Swedish Figure Skating Association and the Organizing Committee for the Leon Lurje Trophy assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event by Competitors and Officials.

The Organizer will not provide participant insurance coverage for the event.

The Organizer will provide emergency medical services for all Competitors during the competition and official practices at the Official arena. The local hospital is in 10 minutes distance from the Ice Rink.
